## Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB) at a glance

- Founded in 1834
- Independent University: recognized by the government and publicly funded
- Comprehensive University: covering all disciplines and all study cycles
  - > 5 Campuses located in Brussels and the Wallon Region
  - 15 Faculties, Schools and Specialized Institutes
  - ➤ 1 Academic Hospital, 1 Cancer Institute and a Network of University Hospital Centres (Brussels, Charleroi)
  - > Staff 6 389 FTEs, 26 000 students (32% from abroad)
  - ➤ Annual budget: 634 m€
  - Excellence of research: 5 Nobel prices, 1 Fields Medal, 17 ERC, 9 HFSP

45 M€ allocated to applied research managed by the TTO: around 30% of the research budget

- 112 active technologies
- 9 new patent applications filed
- Mostly in biotech/health fields

- 46 active licences
- 8 new licences signed
- 37 active spin-offs (48 created since 1992)
- 3 spin-offs created in 2016

- Easier access to scientific skills and equipment available to companies
- Services contracts of the laboratories (analyses, tests, consultancy, studies, etc.)
- Collaborative research involving several partners
- Support in licence grant for a commercial exploitation
