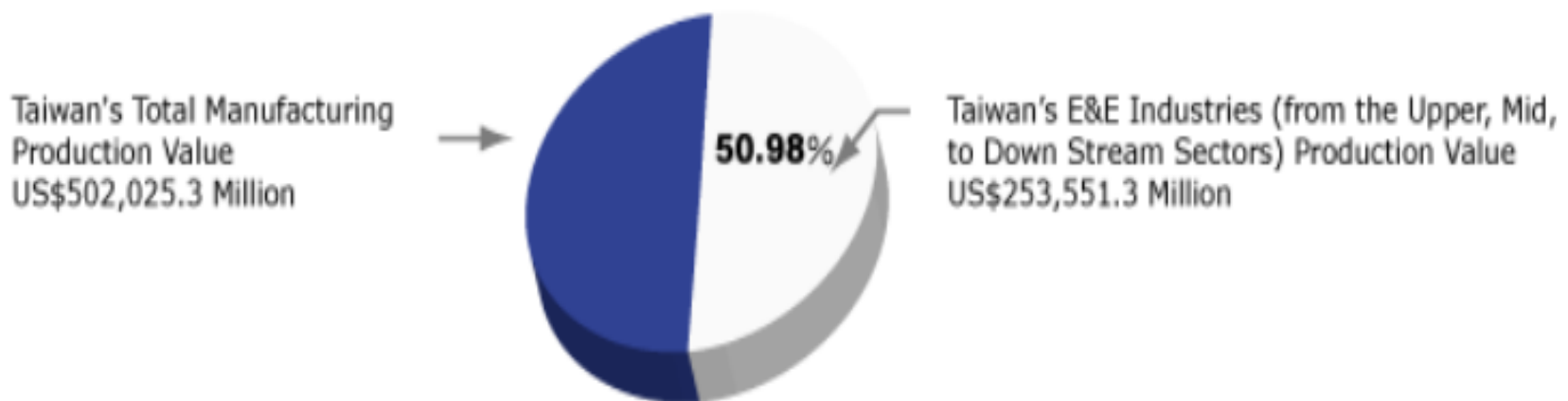
Overview on CNFI

- **Taiwanese high-tech industries have the solution for smart living**

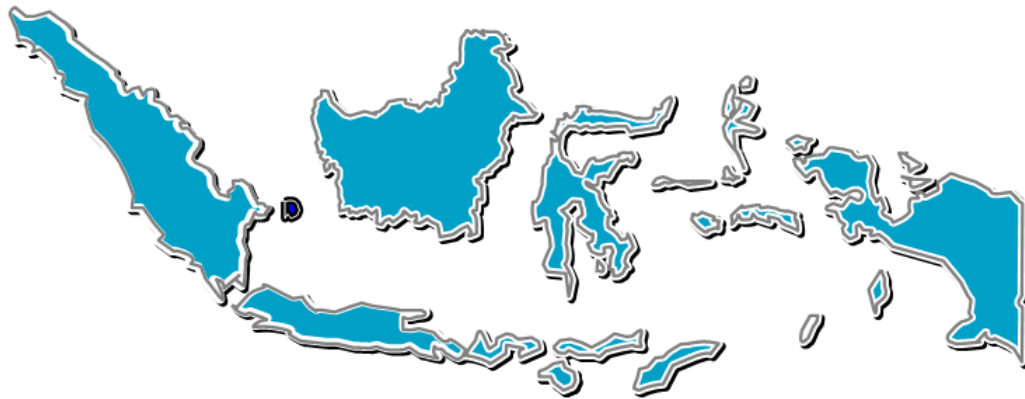
Taiwan in RCEP Boosts Members Economy



- ✓ Taiwan ranked 6 in the **Global Manufacturing Competitiveness Index 2013**
- ✓ Taiwan promotes long term project, including **ADOC** (APEC Digital Opportunity Center) and **OVOP** (One Village One Product), offering RCEP member technical assistance and capacity building
- ✓ Taiwan could input resource in **MPAC** (Master Plan for ASEAN Connectivity) strengthening ASEAN infrastructure

Complementary Indonesia - Taiwan Economy

- Indonesia lead ASEAN in population and total GDP, large domestic market and plenty of natural resources
- Indonesia is Taiwan 10th largest trading partner, reaching US\$12 billion in 2013
- Taiwanese own technology and export to ASEAN mostly intermediate goods or components
