




# Taiwan's LNG and Upstream Activities in Australia

 Taiwan area, 7 projects in 5 countries


#### **Downstream**

- 2 Crackers: Ethylene (1.07 million tons/yr)


#### **Marketing**

- LPG, lubricants, solvents and chemicals




## **Gas Supply**

**♣** Taiwan imported <u>16.81 million tons</u> of LNG in 2018, shared **5.4%** of global LNG imports


